- Facet of the Gospel
 - It is not as if the word of God has failed. - Rom 1:16
- Structure
 - Rom 8:31 "If God is for us, who can be against us?"
 - 9:1-5 Paul's anguish for Israel
 - 6a God's word hasn't failed
 - 6b-13 Promise
 - 14-24 Enemies
 - Is there injustice on God's part? (14) Why does he still find fault? (19)
 - 25-29 Remnant Examples
- Comment
 - 1-5 Paul's anguish
 - Rom (Church) 5:1-5 vs (Israel) 9:4-5
 - 6a God's word hasn't failed - Acts 27:17
 - 6b-13 Promise
 - Israel, Abraham, Isaac (Gen 21:12), Sarah (Gen 18:10), Rebekah (ref Gen 25:21), Jacob-Esau (Gen 25:23; Mal 1:2-3)
 - 8b Children of Promise (not flesh) are counted as offspring
 - 14-24 Enemies
 - Is there injustice on God's part? (14)
 - Why does he still find fault? (19)
 - Moses, Pharaoh (Exo 33:19; 9:16; Hardens 4:21; 7:3; 9:12; 10:1, 20, 27; 11:10; 14:4, 8, 17)
 - 16 Not on human will or effort... God's mercy... 18 Hardens whomever - Acts 9:5
 - Isaiah/Lump (Isa 29:16 mainly, but idea 10:15; 45:9; 64:8; Job 33:13; Jer 18)
 - 23-24 What if God... patience... to make known the riches of his glory... Jews... Gentiles - Rom 2:4; 1:8; 5:21
 - 25-29 Remnant Examples - Judges 7:1-8

- Hose 2:23 context God woos Israel back after Ba'al
 - Hos 1:10 context just had Gomer have baby named Lo-Ammi "not my people"
 - Isa 10:22-23 about remnant returning after Assyria
 - Isa 1:9 and Gen 19:24 comparing near destruction of Uzziah/Assyria to complete destruction of Sodom and Gamorah
- Facet of the Gospel
 - It is not as if the word of God has failed.
- Application Points
 - Anguish for the lost
 - Expect rejection
 - Persecution
 - Patience
 - Remnant - Ways pastor wants to be unpopular - Bible, Repentance and sin, Membership, baptism, discipline, Faithfulness over efficacy
 - Unbeliever - I'm sorry if someone didn't agonize over you. God is patient. Repent and believe while it is still today.
