- Facet of the Gospel
  - As regards the gospel, they are enemies... but as regards election, they are beloved.
- Summary
  - I ask, has God rejected his people? V1-10
    - Elijah v2 1Kings 19:10, 18
    - Remnant v5 Rom 1:9, 13; 9:2, 27, 29; 11:3, 4, 5, 7
    - Israel failed to obtain v7 9:31, 18
    - "God gave them a spirit of stupor" v8 ref Isa 29:10; sim Deu 29:4
    - "Snare and a trap" v9-10 ref 69:22-23
  - I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall? V11-24
    - Salvation has come to the Gentiles 11b
    - Three metaphors 15-24
    - You also will be cut off... if they do not persist in unbelief v22-23 -11:17; Rev 2:1, 5
  - Mystery v25-32
  - O, the depth of the riches... unsearchable v33-36
    - "For, who hath known the mind... counselor" v34 ref Isa 40:13; sim 1Cor 2:16
      - "Or who has given a gift" v35 ref Job 41:11
      - Because of him, and through him... all things... amen Rom 1:25; (8:39); 9:5; 15:33; 16:24

  - For I do not <u>will/want</u> v25 Matt 26:39; Rom 1:13; 7:15-21; 9:16-18
    - To be <u>unknowing</u> Rom 2:4; 6:3; 7:1; 10:3; 1Cor 10:1; 12:1
      - Mystery Matt 13:11; Rom 16:25; 1Cor 2:7; Eph 1:9; 6:19
    - <u>Might not be</u> conceited Matt 10:16; 25:2; Rom 12:16
    - <u>Has come upon</u> Israel Dullness/hardness from part Mark 3:5; Eph 4:18, not Rom 9:18 Adversarial
    - Until <u>Might come in</u> the fullness of the gentiles Fullness Rom 11:12; 13:10; 15:29; Gal 4:4; 1:10; Until - timing Rom 1:13; 5:13; 8:22; 1Cor 4:11; 11:26; boundary Heb 4:12; Acts 13:6
    - V26 And <u>will be saved</u> all Israel Rom 5:9-10; 8:24; 9:27; 10:9, 13; 1Cor 1:18; 1Cor 9:22; all Israel - 9:6; 10:21; 1Cor 10:18; Gal 6:16; all - Rom 11:10, 26, 32, 36; 10:4, 11, 13, 16, 18

- Just as <u>it has been written</u> Just as Rom 1:13, 17, 28; 2:24; 3:4, 8, 10; 4:17; 8:36; 9:13, 29, 33; 10:15; 11:8; 15:3, 7, 9, 21
- "Deliverer <u>will come</u> from Zion, <u>he will banish</u>..." Ref Isa 59:20
- V27 "My covenant... <u>I might take away/remove</u> their sins" Ref Isa 59:21a; Ref Isa 27:9 LXX
- V28 Regards the gospel... enemies... regards election... beloved -Verbless Rom 10:1, 17; Enemies Rom 5:10
- For the gifts and calling of God... irrevocable/not regretted v29 -Irrevocable - 2Cor 7:10; Rom 8:28-30; 9:5; Mal 3:6; Num 23:19; *Charisma* -Rom 1:11; 5:15-16; 6:23; Calling - 1Cor 1:26; Eph 1:18; Phil 3:14; 2Tim 1:9; Heb 3:1
- For just as you were at one time <u>disobedient</u> v30a
  - Now <u>have been mercied</u> by their disobedience v30b
  - So they... have been disobedient ... they might be mercied v31
  - Mercy verb Rom 9:15, 16, 18; 11:30, 31, 32; 12:8; Matt 5:7; 9:27; noun Rom 9:23; 11:31; 15:9; Gal 6:16; Matt 9:13; 2Tim 1:16, 18
  - Disobedient apathy Refuse to be persuaded; Refuse to care vs. Trespass (Rule break, Rom 5:15; 11:11, 12) vs. Sin (Miss Mark, Rom 3:23) vs. Obey as hyper-hearing Rom 10:16; occurance Rom 2:8; 10:21; 11:30, 31; 15:31
- For God <u>has imprisoned</u> them all in disobedience v32 Ensnare Luke 5:6;
  Gal 3:22, 23; Disobedience noun of v30
  - In order to might mercy them all v32b Same verb as v31

  - #2 Timing of "will be saved" v26
