- Glory, on the way to the cross
- Five Solas of the Reformation
  - Sola Scriptura
  - Sola Fide
  - Sola Gratia
  - Solus Christus
  - Soli Deo Gloria
- The Story So Far
  - 10:1-12 Scripture and Divorce
  - 13-31 Grace, Child vs. Rich Man
  - 32-34 Christ, Passion Predicted
  - 35-45 Glory, Not mine to grant, Ransom
  - 46-52 Faith of blind Bartimaeus
- Scripture and Divorce 1-12 (Matt 19:1-12)
  - Whole of scripture (6) (Deu 24:1-3; Genesis 2:24)
  - God's revelation (9)
  - Adultery (11-12)
- Grace, Child vs. Rich Man 13-31 (Matt 19:13-30; Luke 18:15-30)
  - Not that different from 8:34-38; 9:38-50
  - Receive (15, 30) vs. What must I do (17)
  - An Important Distinction
    - *Dexetai* - Receive, accept, welcome (15)
    - *Poieso* - I make, manufacture, do (17)
  - Indignant (14) vs. Loved (21)
  - Possible with God (27) vs. Great possessions, rich person (22, 25)
- Christ, Passion Predicted 32-34 (Matt 20:17-19; Luke 18:31-34)
  - Person - Son of Man (33)
  - Work - ... kill him... rise (34)
- Glory, Not mine to grant, Ransom 35-45 (Matt 20:20-28)
  - In your glory (37)
  - Not mine to grant... it has been prepared (40)
  - Life as ransom/price to free a slave (45)
  - **NOTHING COMPELS GOD**
- Faith of blind Bartimaeus 46-52 (Matt 20:29-34; Luke 18:35-43)
  - Heard... cry out (47)
  - Cried out all the more (48)

- Throwing off his cloak, he sprang up (50)
- Your \_\_\_\_\_ has save/heal/rescue (52)
- Do for you... let me recover my sight (51)
- Chapter 10's Idea
  - God's glory planned in scripture is that Jesus' death and resurrection ransoms those who will receive grace through faith. Only God can accomplish this plan and nothing can compel God. (Isa 53:10-12; Dan 9:24-26)
- Closing
  - Believer - Have you become graceless, Christless, self-glorifying, faithless, or scriptureless?
  - Unbeliever - Your salvation is impossible on your own, but with God all things are possible.
